



Asthma Support Services

Free Medi-Cal covered services for you or your child

If you or your child has asthma, you may qualify for free Medi-Cal services through CalAIM. These services can help reduce asthma attacks, improve daily management, and address triggers inside your home — at no extra cost to you.

Who is eligible: You may qualify if you are:

- Have a diagnosed asthma condition
- Are enrolled in Medi-Cal managed care
- Have been seen by a licensed provider who determined need for CHW services
- Have home triggers contributing to poor asthma control

How to get connected:

- Ask your doctor, case manager, or social worker for a referral
- Self-refer by contacting your Medi-Cal managed care plan
- Referrals accepted from pediatricians, schools, 211 & more

Asthma Prevention Services - Community Health Worker Support

In-Home Trigger Assessment

Trained CHW visits your home to identify environmental asthma triggers like mold, dust, or pests.

Asthma Education

Learn asthma basics: self-monitoring skills, how to use controller & quick-relief medications

Remediation Supplies

Identification and procurement of supplies to reduce home asthma triggers. (Available after APS referral.)

Home Modification Support

Identification and support for home modifications to reduce environmental asthma triggers. (Available after APS referral.)

Asthma Remediation - Community Support

A separate Medi-Cal Community Support that directly addresses and removes environmental asthma triggers inside your home to reduce the frequency and severity of asthma attacks.

Note: This service requires an Asthma Prevention services referral.

Members with complex asthma needs may also qualify for Enhanced Care Management (ECM) to coordinate all care across medical, behavioral, and social needs if they are a frequent user of hospital services, are involved in child welfare, have serious mental health or substance use disorder needs.

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
